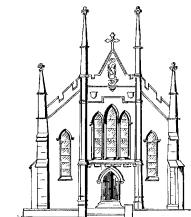

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER - 5th May 2019

TODAY'S READINGS:

Do you love me?...

Rather like us today, St Peter was not perfect. Yet, in spite of his denial of Jesus, he became the head of the apostles, Jesus chose him to be the first pope. We meet Peter in today's Gospel somewhere between his first meeting with the risen Lord in the Upper Room and Jesus' Ascension to the Father. Peter and his companions were fishing - as they had been when Jesus first called them to become fishers of men - this time they were catching nothing, so Jesus tells them to cast their nets to the right side of the boat. It was only after they brought in catch that Peter realised it was the Lord; he jumps into the water, he could not wait to get ashore to be with the risen Jesus. His companions followed with their catch of 153 fish. 153? - this was the number of the then known nations of the world; the apostles would be hauling in people throughout the entire world. Like St Peter we too love Jesus, we may not be able to bring Him a great haul of souls, but we can all care for His people around us.
